

## REGULATIONS

Classes are open to any member of the public and all classes will be judged according to the NAFAS guidelines as stated in the Competitions Manual 2015, the only exception being that entries can be brought wholly or partly assembled (\*please see note below). Unless otherwise stated exhibits will be staged on tabling approx. 68cms in depth covered in cream or blue fabric and backed by blue or cream curtaining. Height from table approx. 107cms. Height of exhibits optional unless otherwise stated.

**NOVICE CLASS** is restricted to those who have not won a First Prize in any show judged by NAFAS Rules. **INTERMEDIATE CLASS** is restricted to those who have not won a 1<sup>st</sup> prize at County, Area or National Competitions.

**PLEASE NOTE** - The marquee will be open for all arrangers between 2pm and 8.30pm on Friday and **for children's and craft classes only** between 8-8.30am on Saturday. All vehicles must leave the showground by 8.30am.

Judging will commence promptly at 8.45am, open to the Public at 10.30am. All exhibits must remain on show until 5.00pm. **NO CARS WILL BE ALLOWED ON TO THE SHOWGROUND TO PICK UP EXHIBITS UNTIL 6pm.** The organisers cannot be held responsible for any exhibits remaining in the marquee after 6.00pm. A free show entrance ticket is available for those entering 2 or more classes and can be collected during staging on the Friday.

Entries close on SATURDAY 13<sup>th</sup> MAY. Please note - late entries will NOT be accepted.

An exhibit to be staged on open tabling 45cm from the ground.  
Space allowed: 92cms. To be viewed all round.  
£15 will be given to entrants of this class (kindly sponsored by Press Gang).
- CLASS 2 Constance Spry  
A traditional style pedestal exhibit. Staged on 90cms provided circular bases (painted cream).  
£10 will be given to entrants of this class (kindly sponsored by Press Gang).
- CLASS 3 Monty Don – In The Potting Shed  
An exhibit.  
Space allowed: 76cms
- CLASS 4 Peter Beales **Novice Class**  
An exhibit featuring roses.  
Space allowed: 60cms
- CLASS 5 Vita Sackville-West **Intermediate Class**  
(The White Garden). An exhibit.  
Space allowed: 76cms
- CLASS 6 Capability Brown – The Formal Garden  
A Pavé/Tapestry exhibit. Space allowed: 60cms  
To be viewed from above and staged on lowered tabling.
